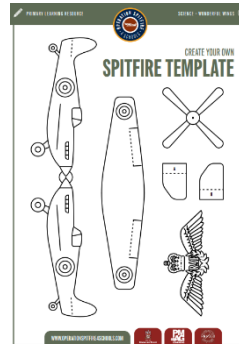
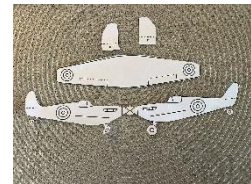


HOW TO MAKE A PAPER SPITFIRE



- Cut out the body, wings and tail of the plane.
- Fold the line for the wings on one side of the body in half and cut along the line with a pair of scissors. Repeat for the other side.
- Place the straw inside the body of the plane so it touches the round circle at the nose of the plane.
- Put a piece of tape around the body of the plane to hold the straw in place.



- Cut the straw to size.



- Thread the wings through the holes in the plane with the elevators (flaps) at the back. Make sure the straw is on top of the wings.



- Add extra tape to the tail of your plane and the wheels or use glue to stick them together.

- Add the rear wings to the plane. Fold them along the dotted line and line up them up to the dotted lines on the plane. Glue or tape them in place.

- Round the wings of your plane by cutting them with a pair of scissors.



TEST YOUR SPITFIRE

- Pull the straw back and add a piece of blu-tack to the front of the straw. Push the straw back in place so the blu-tack sticks to the nose of the plane.



TEST YOUR SPITFIRE



- Make two cuts along the lines on each side of the elevators (flaps) on the wing. Fold up the elevators (flaps) along the dotted line.
